



Greetings to all St. Pius X Families and Friends

We are thrilled to have you come back St. Pius X Church for Mass. In order to do this, we need to ALL abide by the following guidelines set in place by the Green Bay Diocese.

Mass times: Starting June 13/14

Saturday: 4:00 PM

We encourage our seniors and those with special needs to come to this Mass.
Younger families are encouraged to avoid attending this Mass time.

Sunday: 8:30 AM, 10:30 AM and 6:00 PM

We are allowed 25% capacity for the number of members allowed in Church. We will only be able to use every other pew. Couples and families family can sit together. With that said, we will fill the Church first, then the Marian Chapel, then both Narthexes. Please arrive 20 minutes ahead of the Mass start time to allow us time to seat you. **If you're not feeling well, please stay home. Enter at your own risk. If we reach capacity, we may need to ask you to attend a different Mass.**

Please follow the Ushers' guidance. They will be seating you based on their instruction. You might not get to sit in your "normal" seat for a while. Please cooperate with them.

Holy Communion – We will only be distributing Holy Communion and not the Blood of Christ at this time. If you need low gluten hosts, please always go to Father in the center section. We will use a single line, maintaining your distance. Follow the tape on the floor for spacing, and the Ushers' guidance.

Parking: Both East and West lots will be open. If you park in the East lot, you will be sitting on the East side of Church. You will not be able to cross over to the West side of Church or the building.

When Mass is over, please follow the Ushers' guidance as they exit your pew. Then exit immediately. Do not congregate in the Narthex or parking lot. We have a short window to sanitize the areas before the next group comes. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
